## **NDE Due to Failed Suicide Attempt**

NDEs resulting from failed suicide attempts were uniformly characterized as 'unpleasant'. They report that the conflicts that they had attempted suicide to escape were still present when they died, but with added complications.

A man despondent about the death of his wife shot himself, 'died' as a result, and was resuscitated. He states, "I didn't go where [my wife] was. I went to an awful place ... I immediately saw the mistake I had made ... I thought, 'I wish I hadn't done it."

Another man stated, "[While I was there] I got the feeling that two things ... [were] completely forbidden for me to do; ... to kill myself or to kill another person ... If I were to commit suicide, I would be throwing God's gift back in his face ... Killing somebody else would be interfering with God's purpose for that individual."
