In a book by the recently deceased Fr. Emiliano Tardif (1928-1999), we find the following episode. “During a charismatic prayer meeting, we had a woman brought to us who had suffered diabolic oppression for twenty years. No psychiatrist or therapist had been able to bring her relief. We prayed over her for three hours without result.

It occurred to me then to bring her in front of the chapel tabernacle. I told her we were having trouble and suggested that she rest her head on the tabernacle. As she did so, I called out, “Lord, deliver this woman! We don’t know what to do with her.’ I had scarcely said these words when, as if struck by lightning, the woman fell to her knees and began shedding huge tears. She had been set free.

The priest who was with me cried out, ‘Now I truly believe in the Real Presence!’”
